All of these administrative requirements and paperwork take up hours of volunteer time, time we'd rather be spending outdoors with the boys! So do us a favor, and get these things done, and soon, so we don't have to keep asking, and you can join us on our fun activities with your son!

## **VIRTUS Training**

If you volunteer and interact with children under the age of 18, the Los Angeles Archdiocese requires you to take their class on protecting children from child abuse. Similar to the Boy Scout required "Youth Protection Training", these classes are designed to make adults aware of how sexual abuse is perpetrated by adults as well as other children. Classes offered in the near future include:
